## WHY DO YOU NEED MY ID?

Last year ECASD implemented a new safety measure called Raptor. Anytime a visitor comes to the school during the school day and will be outside of the main office area of our school they are to bring identification. A special name tag will be printed, and each person will be asked to stop back into the attendance office before they leave the school.

For any afterschool or larger school event such as a concert this will not be required.

### SKYLERT (INCLUDES TEXTING) STAY INFORMED/STAY CONNECTED

The Eau Claire Area School District uses the Skylert system to communicate with families about emergency situations, weather-related delays/cancellations, and daily attendance. To sign up for Skylert text messages, follow these steps:

- 1. Log in to Family Access via your Skyward account and click on the **Skylert** option listed on the left side.
- To receive text messages, add all cell phone numbers in the Test Message Numbers section in the middle of the screen. (Check with carrier for possible charges.)
- 3. Click on all notification options (School Hours Emergency, Attendance, General...) you would like to receive under **My Skyward Contact Info** AND the **Additional Contact Info** areas. (School Hours Emergency, Attendance, and Non-School Hours Emergency are required categories; you will not be able to uncheck them in the first section.)
- 4. Add additional phone numbers and/or email addresses in the Additional Contact Information area.
- 5. Be sure to click the Save button before you exit.

# FREE AND REDUCED INFORMATION

Thank you for submitting your Household Meal Application each year! These applications are critical because they help the Eau Claire Area School District receive funding for many school programs. If you believe that your student(s) may qualify for free or reduced-price meals, please complete the short application on the last page. A new application is required every year unless you received a letter from the Food and Nutrition Department stating that you do not need to complete an application this school year.

If you fill out an online application, there is no need to fill out a paper application.

We cannot approve an application that is not complete, so be sure to fill out ALL required information.
