School Announcements

State Testing in April

Students will be preparing for the annual Wisconsin Forward Exam the weeks before and after Spring Break. All students will have the opportunity to view informational videos about the test and practice using the testing platform and its tools.

Official days of testing will be April 8-19th; make-up testing will be the week of April 22-26.

Students will need to make sure they are charging their laptops at night. Please encourage your child(ren) to get plenty of rest and eat a healthy breakfast.

The WI Forward Exam is an online summative assessment measuring students' cumulative progress from the past school year. It is administered in ELA and Math for grades 3-8, in Science for grades 4 & 8, and in Social Studies for grades 4, 8 & 10. The exam provides a measure of students' knowledge and skills required to be college- and career-ready.



The Knight's Pantry is available, free of charge, to our DeLong families who could use assistance keeping cupboards stocked and stretching their grocery budget.
