Public Comment

Mark Goings spoke regarding the amounts for a referendum.

• Approval of Previous Minutes

• The minutes from November 20th were reviewed.

Lori Bica made a motion to approve the November 20, 2023 Referendum Committee minutes. The motion was seconded by Marquell Johnson. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

• Referendum Work

- Abby shared a roll forward of the budget with the ESSER positions in the budget for the next 5 years as well as a projection without those positions.
- The group reviewed the last 10 years of the Fund Balance to discuss the impact on the total percentage of Fund 10 expenditures. Auditors recommend being in the 28-33% range. The committee believes that it is important to have a healthy Fund Balance. They are also wondering what the plan is to regain a healthy balance.
- The committee discussed class size actuals vs the public perceptions of the previous 2016 referendum.
- Abby shared the contract renewal calendar and discussed what the process looks like for staffing.
- Abby followed up with Don Lifto about a survey for 2024. He said that a survey wouldn't be ready for an April referendum, but he would recommend that a new survey be done for a November referendum.
- Recurring referendum questions with different amounts were reviewed from other Wisconsin districts.
- In future discussions, what do our students need from a referendum? What are the components of the operational level?

Action Items

- For December 18, can the School Board have additional comprehensive data about the budget long term as well as CPI projections?
- When can we articulate the or else...? What are the ramifications of a failed referendum that will be up for a review for July 1.
