Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the WI Department of Children and Families (DCF) and Child Care Partnership Resource & Referral (CCP) are available to help families fill their urgent child care needs so that they can continue to serve our communities.

Families who are in need of child care can contact Child Care Partnership for a list of regulated child care programs to meet their needs.
