### [Wisconsin Shares](#)

The Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy Program assists families with a portion of child care costs while parents are working or participating in activities that will lead to work and economic self-sufficiency. Parents are required to pay the difference between what the child care provider charges for care and what Wisconsin Shares covers. This is considered the "Parent Share."
