

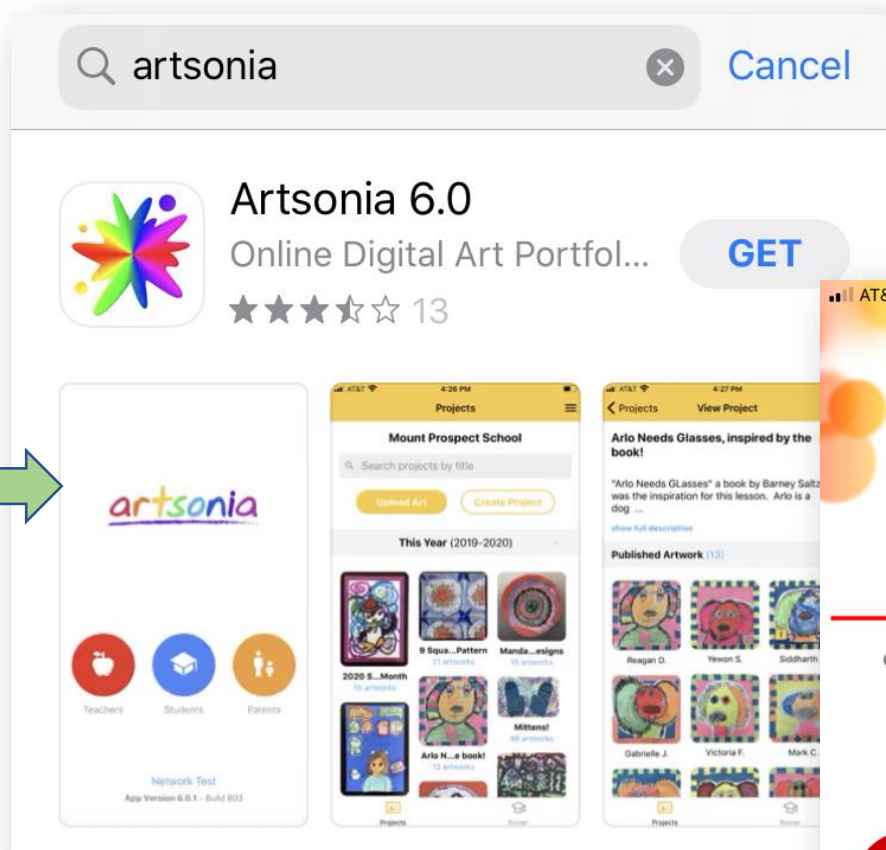

How to upload a photo to our FREE digital art gallery

You can reach the [Artsonia](#) website CLASS PORTAL via a search engine (Takes you to step #4)



OR you may download the free app from the App Store or Google Play Store. **You might need to ask an adult to help!**



2. The open app looks like this.



You will log in as a student. (Parents can look at your art via the "Parents" portal.)

3. Tap on the orange graduation cap icon labeled "Students."



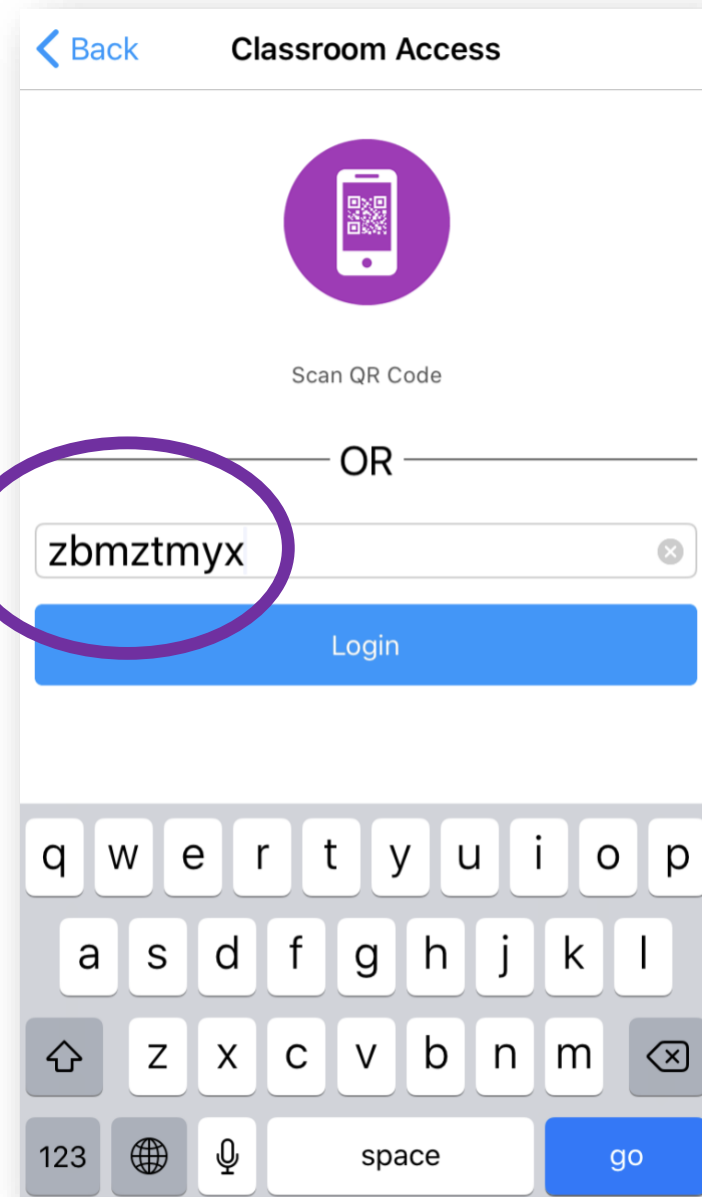
4. Whether you use the [Artsonia](#) website or the app-- you'll **type the school code** that I typed in the box and **tap login** (**OR** you can scan the QR code).

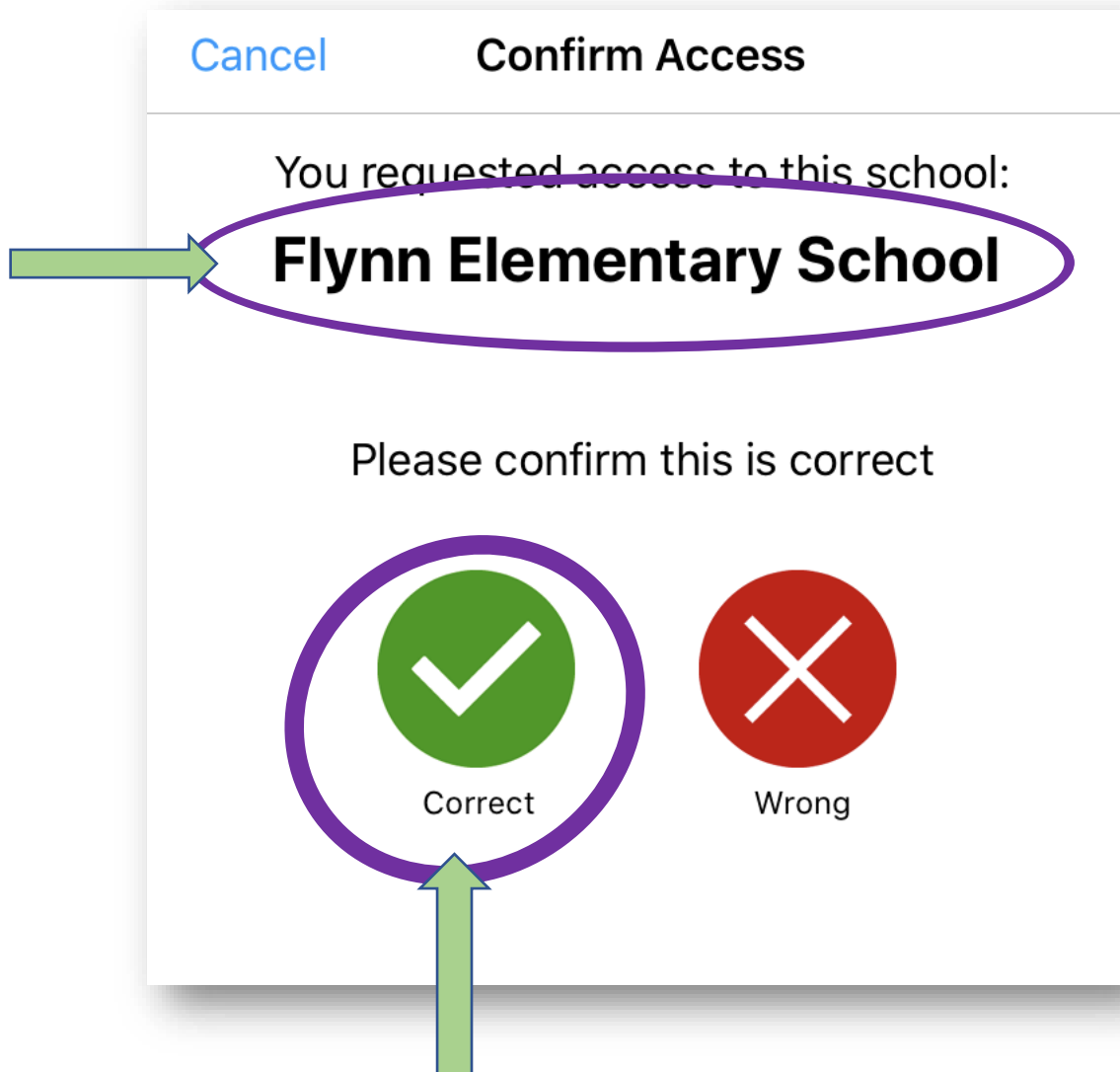

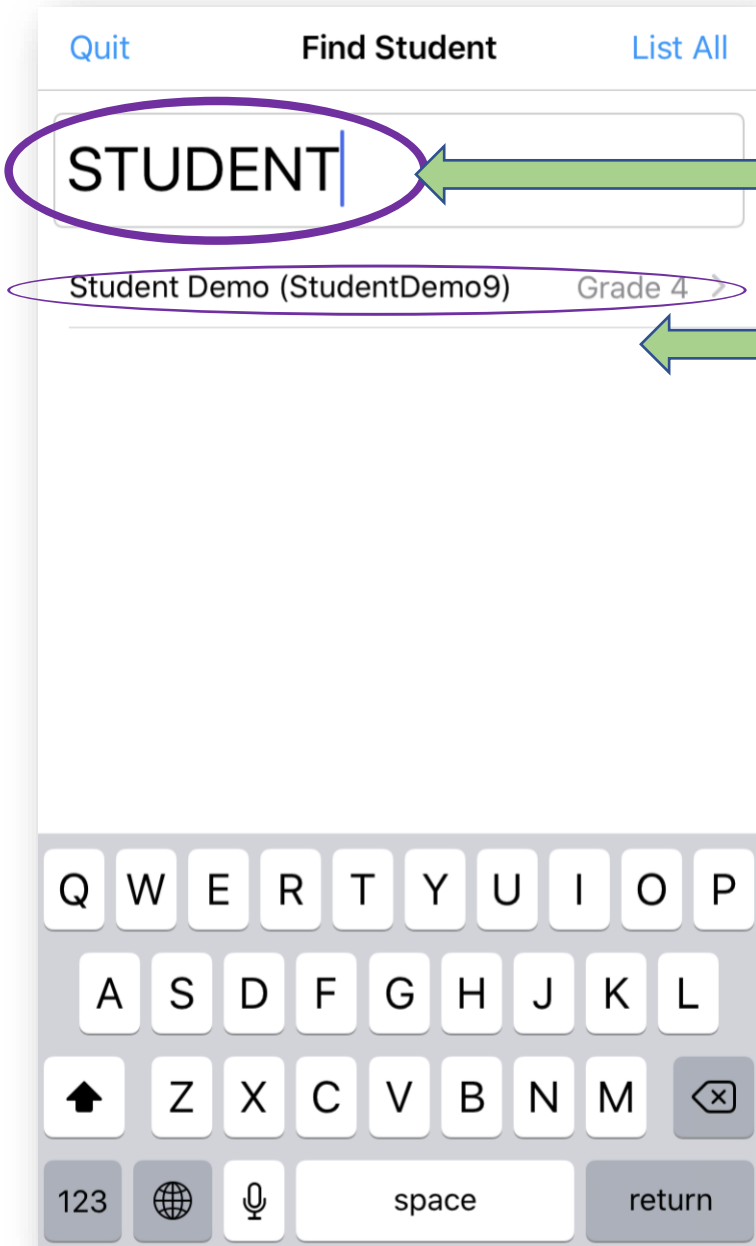


Use the Artsonia app on your device to scan this code.

5. **Tap the green circle** labeled "Correct" to confirm "Flynn Elementary School" popped up.

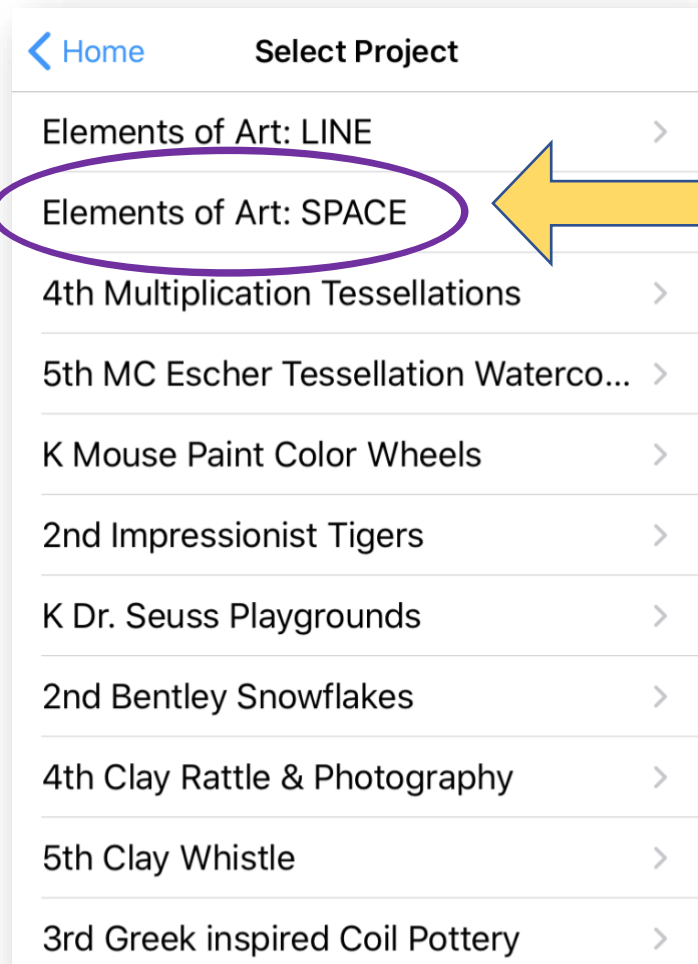
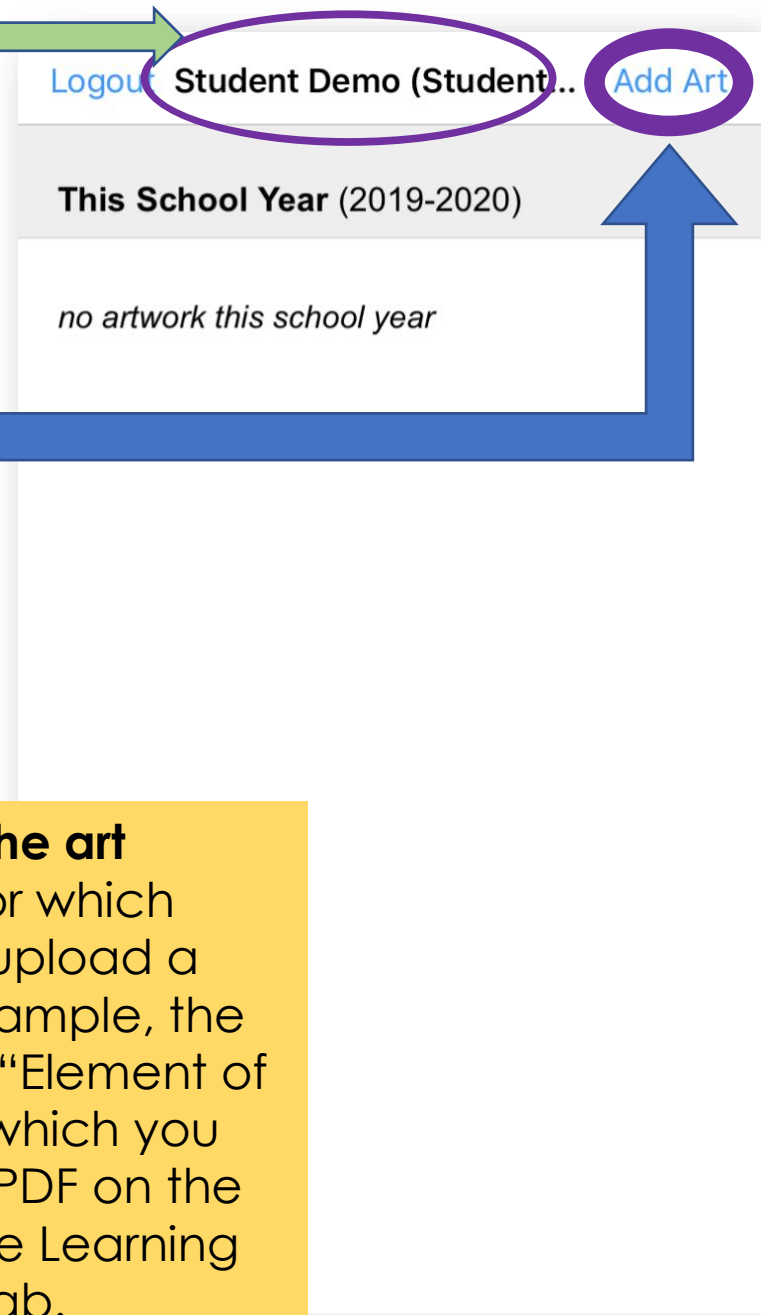


6. **Type your name** into the "Find Student" search box.

7. **Tap on your name** from the list that pops up.

8. **Be sure it's you!** This screen should show ONLY YOUR ART that Ms. Kurtz has already loaded.

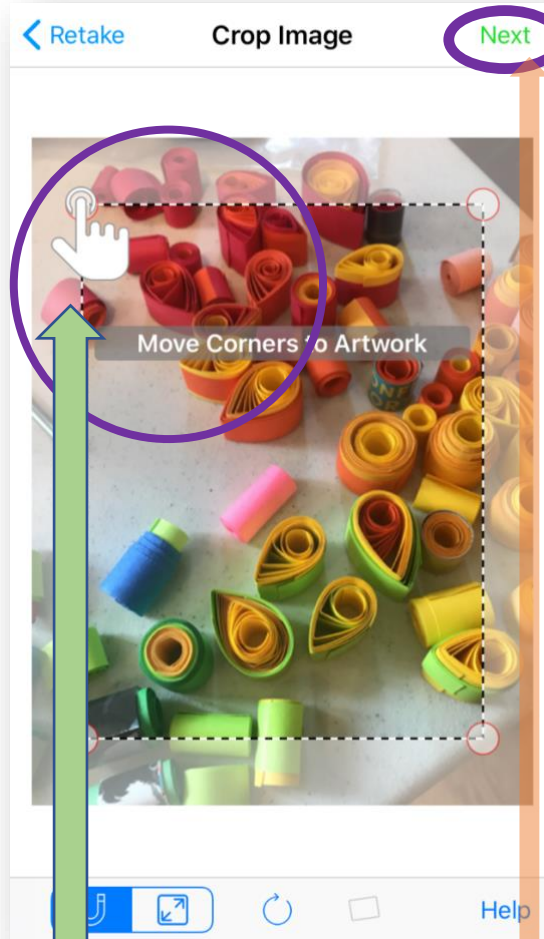
9. **Tap the blue "Add Art"** words in the top right corner of the screen.



10. Next **tap the art project title** for which you'd like to upload a photo. For example, the first project is "Element of Art: SPACE," which you can find in a PDF on the Flynn At-Home Learning Page MAPE tab.

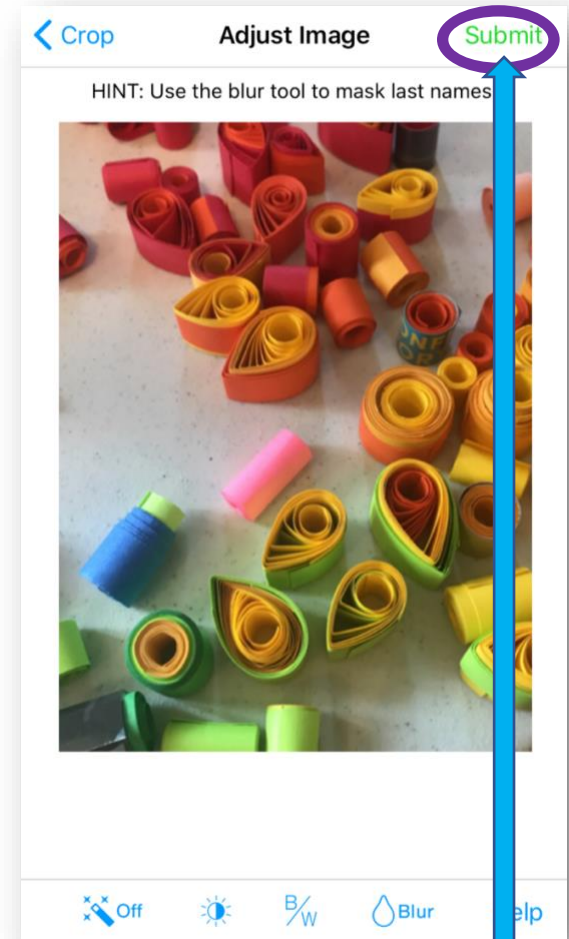


11. **Take a photo** of your art by touching the white circle (or tap **“Import”**—from your camera roll if you took the photo earlier).



12. **Follow the prompts to edit the photo as needed** to crop out any extra stuff in the background of the photo. (This would mainly be for a project on paper.)

13. **Tap the green “Next”** word at the top right corner of the screen when you’re happy with the picture.



14. Be sure to **tap the green “Submit”** word in the top right corner of the screen.
