Minimum Qualifications

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Completed high school credits necessary for graduation.
- Agrees that this will be the last year of high school services and will accept diploma at the end of the school year (2020-2021).
- Meets eligibility requirements for Vocational Rehabilitation services (DVR).
**** In order to participate: all interns MUST be a DVR consumer. ****
- Meets eligibility requirements for long-term support. Screening provided by the Aging & Disabilities Resource Center (ADRC).
- Able to pass drug screen, background check, Mayo Clinic Health System requirements and immunizations are up to date.
- **Has the desire and plans to work competitively in the community at the conclusion of the Project SEARCH program for a minimum of 16 hours per week.**

Preferred Qualifications

- Has independent personal hygiene and grooming skills.
- Has independent daily living skills.
- Maintains appropriate behavior and social skills in the workplace.
- Takes direction from supervisors and changes behavior.
- Is able to communicate effectively with or without accommodations.
- Has reliable transportation or has the willingness to arrange own transportation to and from Mayo Clinic Health System. If appropriate, willing to participate in travel training to insure success in using the city bus/other forms of transportation independently.
- Has previous experience in a work environment (including school, volunteer, and paid work).
