

## Unit 2 Word problems by students: REVIEW

Solve each word problem.

Don't forget about **PAL**! You must have **Proof**:

- **equation** with **variable**
- **picture** that matches the problem
- **answer** with **label**

1. I have candy in rows and columns. I have 7 rows of candy. There are 6 in each row. How many pieces of candy do I have?
2. I have 56 toy kittens. I have them in 7 groups. I have some in each group. How many kittens are in each group?

By Teagan:

3. In Mr. Star's class, 3 people have 25 stars. They put the stars in 5 equal rows. How many stars are in each row?
4. I have 81 toys to put away in 8 bins, with an equal number in each bin. How many can I put in each bin equally? How many toys will be left over, not in a bin?

By Isaac:

5. There were 10 book shelves (rows) in the library. There were 6 books on each shelf. How many books in the whole library?
6. I have 80 Legos. I put them into groups. Each group has 8 Legos. How many groups did I make?

By Evelyn:

7. Mrs. David hung drawings the students made for her. There are 3 drawings in each row. She hung them in 5 rows. How many drawings did students give her?

8. I have 5 rows of apples, with 7 in a row. How many apples in all?
9. I have 56 toys. Mom told me to put them in 8 bins, equally. How many did I put in each bin?

By Graham:

10. Furley has rows of balls. There are 40 balls, with 5 in each row. How many rows does he have?
11. There are 8 cats in each kennel. (That's a lot of cats in a kennel!) There are 56 cats in total. How many kennels are there?
12. I have a rug that is 5 feet long and 6 feet wide. What is the area of my rug?

13. I put letters in an array. I put the letters in one row, with 1 in each row. How many letters do I have?
14. There are 9 markers in each bin. If there are 54 markers in all, how many bins are there?

15. I have 3 rows of stickers. There are 6 in each row. How many stickers do I have?
16. I cook 72 pieces of pizza. Each person at the party gets to eat 8 slices. Everyone gets the same amount. How many people are at the pizza party?

17. I put candy in an array. I put 5 rows of candy, with 6 in each row. How many pieces do I have in all?
18. I have 64 fish in a tank. 28 are goldfish, and the rest are clownfish. How many clownfish do I have?

19. Our class pets are cats. The cats sit in rows of 6, with 5 in each row. How many cats are in our class in all? (That would be fun if we could have class cat pets!)

20. In Ms. Suralski's class, the 22 students put stickers on a wall. The students each put 10 stickers on the wall in groups of ten. How many stickers were on the wall total?
21. I have 63 apples. I put them in bags with 7 in each bag. How many bags of apples do I have?

22. I have 8 rows of pigs, with 5 in each row. How many pigs do I have?
23. I have 63 Legos. I gave 45 to my friend, and 12 to my mom. How many Legos did I keep?

24. The students in the art room want to hang their art in 3 rows, with 6 pictures in each row. Each student hangs 1 picture. How many students are in the art room hanging pictures?
25. I have 48 sharp pencils. I want to put them in equal groups in pencil boxes. If I have 9 pencil boxes, how many pencils can go in each box? How many pencils will be left over and NOT in a box?

26. I baked muffins in my muffin pan that has 7 in a row. It has 8 rows. How many muffins did I bake?
27. I made 16 loaves of bread. I put 2 loaves on each pan. How many pans do I put bread on?
