### ECASD Password Reset (10th-12th grades only)

On **Monday, October 30**, all students in 10-12 grade at North will have a brief presentation regarding password security during Husky Time. **They will be required to change their password at that time.** If students are not in Husky Time on Monday, their account will be set to force a password change on the next log in. **If your student is absent, please follow these directions on how they can change their password:**

1. Open a web browser on your laptop and go to the ECASD Start Page
2. Click the Microsoft 365 icon.
3. If you are not signed in, sign in using your ECASD email and current password.
4. Click on your name in the upper right corner and choose View Account.
5. Click Cancel on the Feedback prompt (you may not see this prompt, that is ok).
6. Click Change Password.
7. Enter your old password and your new secure password in the appropriate boxes.
8. Click Submit.
9. RESTART YOUR COMPUTER.
  - a. (Click the Windows icon, Power icon and then choose Restart).
10. After your computer reboots, do not sign in as normal. Click the Other User link and enter your full email address in the username field and enter your new password in password field. Please see our IT specialist Blake Reitz or Marina Dahlke for further assistance.

## IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



**HOLD!** In your room or area. Clear the halls.

**STUDENTS**

Clear the hallways and remain  
in room or area until the "All  
Clear" is announced.

Do business as usual.

**ADULTS**

Close and lock the door  
Account for students, visitors and  
others.

Do business as usual.



**SECURE!** Get inside. Lock outside doors.

**STUDENTS**

Return to inside of building  
Do business as usual.

**ADULTS**

Bring everyone indoors  
Lock outside doors  
Increase situational awareness  
Account for students, visitors and others  
Do business as usual.



**LOCKDOWN!** Locks, lights, out of sight.

**STUDENTS**

Move away from sight  
Maintain silence  
Do not open the door  
Prepare to evade or defend.

**ADULTS**

Recover people from hallway if possible  
Close and lock the door  
Turn out the lights  
Move away from sight  
Maintain silence  
Do not open the door  
Prepare to evade or defend.



**EVACUATE!** (A location may be specified)

**STUDENTS**

Leave stuff behind if  
required to  
If possible, bring your phone  
Follow instructions.

**ADULTS**

Lead evacuation to specified location  
Account for students, visitors and others  
Notify if missing, extra or injured people.



**SHELTER!** Hazard and safety strategy.

**STUDENTS**

Use appropriate safety strategy  
for the hazard.

**ADULTS**

Lead safety strategy  
Account for students, visitors and others  
Notify if missing, extra or injured students  
or adults.

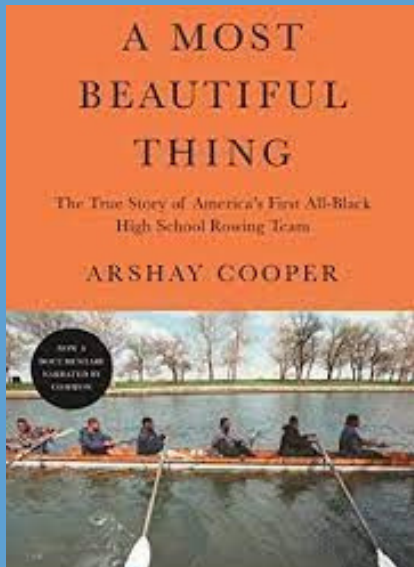

# NHS HIGHLIGHTS

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In English 10, students are reading *A Most Beautiful Thing* by Arshay Cooper. (<https://www.arshaycooper.com/>) The memoir is the "...moving true story of a group of young men growing up on Chicago's West side who form the first all-Black high school rowing team in the nation, and in doing so not only transform a sport, but their lives." After high school, Cooper studied at Le Cordon Bleu, became a personal chef, and published his memoir in 2020. As students are reading and interacting with this text this year, teachers have been delighted to see immersed in a complex text that they enjoy and which has led to rich classroom discussions around a diverse text.

Arshay Cooper is speaking to all 10th graders (8:30–9:20), attending a culinary class (9:55–10:45), and hopefully meeting with a small group of students (10:50–11:40 or during lunch) on November 2. This is partially grant funded through the Eau Claire Public Schools Foundation EDI Grant. Students and staff are very excited for this opportunity.

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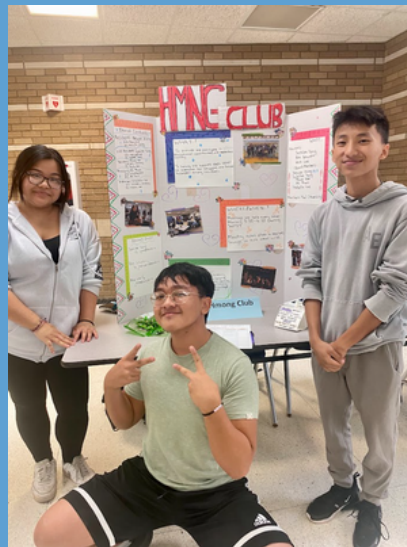
