A group of parents in the Eau Claire community have come together to support and celebrate our seniors as they prepare to graduate from high school in May. Please help us celebrate and create lasting memories for the Class of 2021 by volunteering to help in one (or more!) of the following areas:

Yard Signs

This group will coordinate all activities to get yard signs for all ECASD schools (North, Memorial, McKinley, EC Virtual School) to families. This includes where to get them, design, and the best ways to distribute.

This group will create signs, coordinate others to make signs and decorate the fences at each high school the last week of May. Signs may stay up for two weeks before takedown.
