***Alvin and Marcia Lechleitner Scholarship Fund**

The purpose of the Alvin and Marcia Lechleitner Scholarship Fund is to support the post-secondary education of graduating seniors at North High Schools who plan to pursue a degree in teaching Pre-K to Grade 12, including special needs education. Graduates who plan to attend a two-year school for generals before continuing on to a four-year degree or a four-year post-secondary educational institution are qualified to apply.

J. Murphy STEM Scholarship

All North and Memorial High School seniors who intend to pursue post-secondary education and study under a STEM program major (science, technology, engineering, math) and will be pursuing a career in a STEM field will be considered for this scholarship. Selection is based on an intent to attend a post-secondary education program with a STEM field major and plans to pursue a career in a STEM field. Students must have a GPA of a B average or higher (3.0) and must demonstrate financial need (detailed in your FAFSA SAR). Students are required to provide a recommendation letter from a teacher. Preference is given to students planning to attend a public university and preference is also given to female applicants. Scholarship amount is \$10,000 renewable annually for four years of post-secondary education.

***Edwin C. and Lucille M. Eggen Scholarship**

Applicant must be currently enrolled as a high school freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior (graduating class of 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027) and must be a United States citizen or eligible non-citizen. Financial need is NOT considered; all income levels are encouraged to apply. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 each with multiple winners to be selected. Each award is a non-renewable, one-time award and is to be used exclusively to offset costs and fees related directly to the student's first year of higher post-secondary education at an accredited institution of the student's choosing within the US.
