Referendum Committee Report (GC-5)

Legislative Liaison

Commissioner Farrar provided a Legislative update, which included the following:

The state Senate approved SB 395 related to the low revenue ceiling, as well as SB 83 which now requires a municipality, county, or school district to post accrued interest estimates on the ballot for a referendum. The Assembly will be voting on two bills focused on eliminating certain race-based programs and considerations from higher education institutions. The Senate will also be voting on SB 333, which is

designed to close a loophole in current Wisconsin law that neglected to regulate certain sexual crimes between school personnel and students.

FOCUS ON RESULTS

Mandy Van Vleet, Executive Director of Teaching and Learning, presented information on how our District is creating and sustaining a supportive learning environment, a safe space where students feel welcome, accepted, and valued. Social emotional learning is equally important as academics because when such an environment is created, students engage in learning. The desired outcomes of such an environment include psychological well-being, engagement and motivation, confidence and self-esteem, collaboration and teamwork, personal growth and development, and positive relationships.

Michele Wiberg, Principal at DeLong Middle School; Karen Gullicksrud, AVID Site Coordinator and Math Teacher; and Mitch Demers, SEL Instructional Coach, shared information on what they are doing at DeLong. To build such an environment for students, there must be support for teachers where we provide them with what they need so they can implement in the classroom. This includes allocating staff and resources, along with professional learning and skill instruction. Student voice is also important. Discussion and questions followed.

MONITORING DISTRICT RESULTS

Superintendent Johnson presented the monitoring report for OE-3, Climate Commitment, in which the ECASD commits to immediate and ongoing action toward a goal of achieving 100% renewable energy and carbon neutrality for the District by 2050. Jeff Nestor, General Manager of Facilities, also provided information, including a biodiversity rubric and stated that, "As we move forward in some of these things,

our expectations need to grow also." Of special note, elementary schools are beginning to compost. Discussion and questions followed.
