- **Public Comment – Pete Riley**
 - No public comment.
- **Approval of May Minutes – Pete Riley**

- **Update on Documentary Theater**
 - There was a family emergency that prevented the June meeting. Meeting again on July 15. Amber is aware that she will be putting together a performance appraisal annually to be reviewed by LEAP.
