Provides work experience & training to intern in 3 unpaid internships throughout the 9 months.

Provides skills training to intern in their departments & assists intern in finding employment upon graduation.



FAMILY



Provides support to intern outside of Project SEARCH & attends intern employment meetings to discuss progress.
