- English language learners enrolled

  - This teacher will have two classes K-1 (13 students enrolled) and 2-3 classes (13 students enrolled)
  - o 16 students enrolled 4-5th grade
  - o 33 students enrolled 6-8th grade
  - o 9-12 (10 9th, 13 10th, 11 11th, 14 12th graders)
  - Brings possibility for community for each grade level
