Here is a snapshot of the Third Grade Essential Learning for the week. *Reminder: students log into the Third Grade Meadowview Google Classroom (via google classroom app) to access all links and assignments.*

- **Math**

- Unit 3 (multi-digit addition and subtraction) in the **ThinkCentral app**. One lesson per day:

Monday	----- no assignment -----
Tuesday	Lesson 3.11 - Ungroup to Subtract
Wednesday	Lesson 3.12 – Subtract Across Zeros
Thursday	Lesson 3.13 – Discuss Methods of Subtraction
Friday	Lesson 3.14 – Relate Addition and Subtraction

- **Writing**

- **Daily Writing Prompt** (link in google classroom app) – Students type a reply (about a paragraph in length)
- **Frequently Misspelled Third Grade Words** - students practice new words (watch for video from Mr. Pedersen) AND check skills with a Kahoot game on Friday - all links in Google Classroom. Be sure to download the app *Notability*!

- **Reading**

- **Students will read What Happens When You Flush, a third-grade-level text** (in google classroom).
 - Students listen to it read aloud or read the PDF copy independently.
 - Students answer discussion/comprehension questions posted
- Additional Daily reading for 30 minutes. Students can read a book, magazine, read with the Sora app, etc. Teacher read alouds are also posted for students to listen to.
