#### • Public Comment

#### Approval of Minutes

o The minutes from April 21, 2022, were reviewed.

#### • Data Review

- Kim reviewed data gathered from committee previous questions. They discussed how ECVS and the
  flexible boundaries are impacting the overall capacity and enrollment at the schools. Principal insight
  was shared from Longfellow, Northwoods, and Meadowview and their feedback about their current
  building situations for student and staff space.
- Construction within the City Limits was shown to the group and the data shows that there is more construction in the City Limits that there has been in the past 10 years. These new homes are not reflected in projected enrolment data at this time.
- Data was shared for the capacities of the building that ECASD uses compared to the ATSR capacity of how the building spaces are actually being used. The numbers show different pictures in the everyday learning spaces for students.
