- Sample questions were shared so the committee could discuss the wording to get exactly what ECASD wants for the referendum. There was a question on wording for 'capital projects' in the final question. Discussion ensued on how the wording in the question would end up.

Action Items

- How many students and families are using the community partnerships for mental health services and how is this information getting out to families (include establishment date)?
- Can the white words in the question be updated to be less words?
- Is turf environmentally friendly? Are there benefits to having 1 community facility?

Wrap-up Meeting

 - Continuing the referendum work
 - Budget for 5 years flat and 5/10 years for where we anticipate salary and benefits to go
 - Budget with and without ESSER funds so the community can see the deficit of funds
