Did you know?

Your children can still attend Eau Claire Area School District (ECASD) even if your family lives in Altoona, Augusta, Cadott, Chippewa Falls, Eleva, Fall Creek, etc.

What is Open Enrollment?

The inter-district public school open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend public school in a school district other than the one in which they reside.

Who can apply?

Any Wisconsin resident in 4K to grade 12 may apply to attend a nonresident school district under the open enrollment program.

When can parents apply?

The regular open enrollment application period begins in February and ends in April. Additional information on the regular open enrollment application season and the best way to apply is online at www.dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment.
