- Kim shared a review of the enrollment projections at the Secondary Level from the APL study and shared that at this time North High School is 100 students over that projection.
- Kurt Madsen shared what it is like to be in a secondary building that is overcrowded. The building has been repurposing storage rooms and other underutilized spaces to accommodate all students.
- Jeff Nestor shared a few different options for additions and renovations of the current North High School building and what costs, or benefits would be included with those changes. Options included designs to help get students college community ready as well!
- There was a group discussion on the pros and cons of the renovations. The overall theme was that the 8 classrooms for some of the additions may not be enough. They also noted about the south side of town and the new homes/apartments coming in and how that may affect common spaces in other buildings.
