ECASD MEALS

- ECASD will be providing free breakfast and lunch to students on what would have been regularly scheduled school days while schools are closed. (No breakfast or lunch will be offered during the week of Spring Break March 23 through March 27).
- Free breakfast and lunch can be picked up at the following locations: Delong, Northstar and South, Tuesday, March 17th through Friday, March 20th from 11:30 am. and 1:00 pm.
- Pick up locations will be outside the middle schools and will be served in a "grab and go" fashion.
- Meals will include lunch for the current day and breakfast for the following day. All meals will be free regardless of current eligibility status or location of enrollment.
- USDA has eliminated the requirement that students be present to pick-up the meals.
