



# 100% Virtual Option\*

## **Learning happens every day.**

Quality content will be provided daily for students. Learning will include “live lessons” (synchronous learning) and independent (asynchronous) lessons. Because access to digital tools is now available to all students, remote learning differs from the spring of 2020. Students will experience daily instruction with a teacher who uses a variety of methods and structures including lessons with new content, practice sessions, collaboration with peers, small group work, one-to-one lessons and more.

## **Content taught matches ECASD curriculum.**

The resources and materials used in each course follow the curriculum being taught during the blended model. When students are ready to return to their regular classroom experience, the transition from being 100% remote will be seamless.

## **Students remain enrolled in their school.**

Enrollment for your family will not change. Students will have an ECASD teacher and remain in their same school.

## **Teachers are ECASD employees.**

Quality, licensed teachers from the ECASD will teach the 100% remote classes. They have access to resources and materials shared across the District and will provide rigorous content and engaging instruction for students.

## **Schedules coordinate with the blended option in your school.**

The 100% virtual option for remote learning uses a schedule that coordinates with other schools using the blended model. This serves several purposes. It allows for sharing of resources and assists in a seamless transition when we are safely able to return to face-to-face instruction. Most importantly, students will experience learning 5 days every week.

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- Note: The 100% virtual option for remote learning described here is not affiliated with the Eau Claire Virtual School (ECVS). ECVS is a charter school within the District and offers unique curriculum and resources. Families who choose the 100% virtual option described above for remote learning remain enrolled in the ECASD, follow the course of study offered by the district, and share resources, staff, and schedules within the District.
