Payments will be paid directly to the landlord on behalf of the tenant.

Eligibility

Applicants must be an adult Wisconsin resident with a household income at or below 80% of the county median income in the month of or prior to the application date. **If all adults in the household are ineligible non-citizens, a child or minor head-of-household with a Social Security Number (SSN) may apply.**
