### Vocalic or Vowel R (ar, or, er, ear, air, ire)

### Bunched (retracted) for vocalic /r/

- -Tongue is pulled back and the tip disappears.
- -The back sides of the tongue should be touching the upper back molars (in the picture they are not, but it's difficult to capture tongue placement in a picture).
- -The tongue is essentially smiling.
- -Verbal cue: bunch your tongue tight
- -Visual cue: hand gesture, motion (hold hand out flat, palm facing down, pull hand back to make a mountain)







### Tip up (retroflex) for vocalic /r/

- -Tongue tip is up and you should not be able to see it.
- -The sides of the tongue should be touching the upper back teeth/molars.
- -The tip of the tongue should not touch the roof of mouth, but be close.
- -Middle roof of the mouth is crucial. Too far back yields a glottal or throaty sound and too far front yields an /l/ or /l/ like sound if the tongue flips down too fast after making the /r/ sound.
- -Verbal cue: grand sweep, tongue tip up
- -Visual cue: hand gesture, motion (hold hand out flat, palm facing up, curl fingers up towards body like you are closing your hand)





- Voice on






