JUNIORS - You are scheduled to take the ACT test on Wednesday, April 10th.

Remember to get a good night's sleep and eat a good breakfast in the morning. An optional breakfast will be served in the cafeteria until 7:45am. You will be admitted to your test room at 7:45am.

Please bring the following to the test:

- Your district issued laptop, fully charged because the test is online.
- A photo ID (Driver's License or School ID)
- No. 2 pencils with erasers
- Calculator for the Mathematics Test
- Water (a light snack will be provided, but you can bring your own snack if you choose)

Students should NOT bring to the test:

- Cell phone/Apple Watch/any other electronic device
- Homework/outside reading material.

The annual ACT assessment for the 11th grade students will occur on April 10th, 2024. All Juniors should report to their testing rooms by 7:45am. The ACT is scheduled to conclude by 1:09pm.

The 9th, 10th and 12th grade students will have online Canvas learning from 7:35am to 1:09pm. Students may complete their work off campus or at Memorial High School. Students who report to the building during this time should go to the Library, Commons, or gymnasium.

Starting at 1:41pm, <u>all</u> students will have Extended Learning Time (ELT) in the building. April 10th is an instructional day, so attendance will be recorded. Please see the included schedule.

Busses will operate on their regular schedule. Breakfast will be served before school and lunch will be provided from 1:09-1:41pm.


Interested in membership to the National Honor Society?

Open Enrollment is February 5 through April 30, 2024

What is Public School Open Enrollment?

Wisconsin's inter-district public school open enrollment program allows students and families who don't live in our district to open enroll into the Eau Claire Area School District.

Who May Participate?

Wisconsin residents in grades K-12 may apply to participate in open enrollment. Students in pre-kindergarten may participate in limited circumstances; parents should call the Executive Director of Business Services at 715-852-3010 to find out if their preschool-aged children qualify.

How and When May Parents Apply?

The regular open enrollment application window will be February 5, 2024, through April 30, 2024, for the 2024-2025 school year. Parents may submit online applications beginning February 5, 2024, at the Wisconsin Department of Instruction website at https://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment. Please call 715-852-3127 or email districtadministration@ecasd.us for more information.

Have you moved out of the district during the 2023-2024 school year?

If so, you must apply for a Tuition Waiver to continue attending the Eau Claire Area School District for the remainder of the 2023-2024 school year. Contact the Enrollment Office at 715-852-3127 or email <u>districtadministration@ecasd.us</u> for an application.

Students Currently Attending the ECASD Through a Tuition Waiver

Students who have moved outside of the district during the 2023-2024 school year and are currently attending school under a Tuition Waiver <u>must</u> apply for open enrollment during the regular application window, February 5, 2024, through April 30, 2024, to continue attending during the 2024-2025 school year.

Current Open Enrollment Students

Students currently attending the Eau Claire Area School District under the open enrollment law do not need to reapply.

Other Information

Students who move into the district after January 2024 and anticipate moving out of the district before the 2024-2025 school year will not be eligible for a Tuition Waiver. Students <u>must</u> apply for open enrollment during either the regular open enrollment or alternative open enrollment period to be eligible to attend the Eau Claire Area School District during the 2024-2025 school year.

School Placement

By completing an open enrollment application, you are applying to attend the Eau Claire Area School District. You have the opportunity to indicate which school your child would prefer to attend; however, the district will determine placement based on space availability.
