

#### **Final Transcripts**

- 1. Request through Parchment NOW. Scroll down to the bottom of MHS home page and click on blue/white button that says Order Records. In Parchment, select "Hold for Grades" for your final transcript. Send only to the one school you plan to attend. Athletes: the NCAA will also need a final transcript.
- 2. Make sure your Parchment profile has a personal email address not your school email address.
- 3. Final transcripts will not be sent until after the last week in June. You can check and see if your transcript has been sent by checking your Parchment account.
- 4. Currently free, if you wait to do this after August 1, it will cost you \$4.00 per transcript.

#### **Important Reminders**

- If you are attending a 4-yr University, they typically request students take a **PLACEMENT TEST** prior to course registration in the summer. You can take this at UWEC (campus choice does not matter, if you are attending a UW school), based on availability. Some schools will use your ACT scores for placement-check with your college admissions office. IF you need to register, you can do so at <a href="https://testing.wisc.edu/centerpages/regionaltesting.html">https://testing.wisc.edu/centerpages/regionaltesting.html</a>
- If you will be attending a college in Minnesota, it is important to complete a Reciprocity Agreement to obtain a reduced tuition cost. THIS IS NOT AUTOMATIC; you will be billed "out-of-state" tuition if you do not fill this out and submit it to your school. This will save you money. 
