## Final Transcripts

- Request through Parchment NOW. Go to the MHS homepage, scroll down, and you will see the transcript request area on the left- hand side. In Parchment, select “Hold for Grades” for your final transcript. Send only to the one school you will be attending. Athletes: the NCAA will also need a final transcript sent to them.
- Please make sure your Parchment profile has your personal email address not your school email address.
- Final Transcripts will not be sent until all grades for all students have been processed which will be no later than the last week in June. You can check the status of your final transcript by logging into your Parchment account.
- Currently final transcripts are free, if you wait until August 1 there will be a charge of \$4.90 per transcript.

The University of Wisconsin Center for Placement Testing recently announced that Placement Testing will only be offered online this Spring. We will be sure to provide more information regarding Placement Tests as it becomes available.
