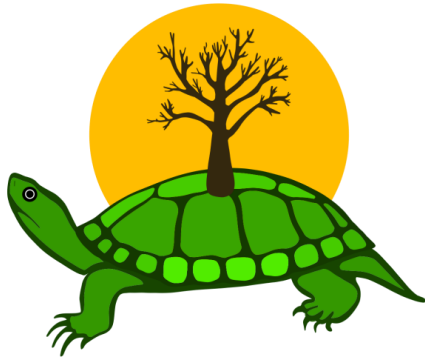

## *What is the Title VI Indian Education*

The Title VI program is funded through a federal grant from the Department of Education. The program offers services and resources to Native American students to help them succeed.



There is an American Indian Education Coordinator at the Eau Claire Area School District. The Coordinator plans cultural programming to address cultural needs and is available to assist students and families with educational needs.

## Title VI Services Include:

### Advocacy

Advocate for the needs of Native American Students within the Eau Claire Area School District. Collaborate with administration and school staff to support student needs.

### Cultural Programming

Coordinate events for Title VI students and their families, collaborate with tribes and other outside organizations to make events more accessible and to make our Native American culture more prevalent within the community.

### Title VI Parent Committee Meetings

Collaborate with the Johnson O'Mally Program to organize parent committee meetings to provide parents with a forum to share feedback and discuss needs in the community.

### Grade and Attendance Monitoring

Connect students to resources to help them obtain satisfactory grades and improve attendance.
