


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## *An Important Message from the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Teachers*

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Dear families,

We know that this has been a difficult situation for everybody. We have been working hard to prepare materials so that your child does not fall behind and can continue to grow and succeed in 5<sup>th</sup> grade. We gave the students a lot of directions today about things they can be doing over the next few weeks to keep their brains strong. We talked about how the brain is another muscle that needs to be exercised, and we provided them with things that will allow them to do so.



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### *Online Learning*

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5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers have worked to create materials for your child to complete at home. Look for an email coming out soon for more details! The students will be able to access Canvas from their iPads at home. (No internet service at home? No problem! See the next page.) In addition, we have provided them with math packets to practice previous skills learned as well as a few topics they have covered in past years, but we have not yet discussed this year. They can complete these at home, using their math notebooks to help them. We will post answer keys to the math page of Canvas soon. They also should be keeping an eye on the social studies page for information about our Roanoke Island project. Working on writing will be done through Google Docs. They will be typing of their drafts (that we will then edit together when they return). Finally, we have reading. I encourage each child to read at least 30 minutes per day! Reading is fundamental to keeping your brain sharp! We will also be uploading some practice prompts to Canvas in the Language Arts section for them to work on specific reading skills.

Please continue to look for more updates in the next few days, as we are working on gathering everything we can to help your child be successful.
