

SAMPLE PBIS At-Home Behavior Matrix

At South Middle School, staff uses a chart with desired behaviors, including a description of how those behaviors will look like in each setting. There are behavior matrices for each school setting: classroom, hallway, bathroom, etc. In the classroom, teachers ask students to have all materials needed for the class out before class begins. This is a description of how students are “Ready” in the classroom. Creating a set of expectations like this for use at home will help your child to understand what is expected in each setting. Here is an *example*:
